Resolution #137 – School District 24 Top Five (5) Priorities for the 2020-2024 Five Year Capital Plan Amendment

Whereas, Community Education Council for District 24 “CECD24” developed and identified these top 5 Capital Plan district needs based on school community feedback:

Priority #1 – New Extension with Gym for IS 61. Students need a proper setting and additional classroom space to offset increasing enrollments for the school population;

Priority #2 – Bathroom Renovation at PS 143. Bathrooms are deteriorating. The lack of functioning bathrooms creates problems for the students;

Priority #3 – Window replacements are needed at IS 61. There are many broken and leaky windows throughout the old section of the building.

Priority #4 – Auditorium upgrade is needed at PS89. The seats and flooring create a dangerous situation for the school community;

Priority #5 – Bathroom Renovation at PS 14. The bathrooms on the 1st and 4th floors are deteriorating. Also they are not ADA compliant and the lack of functioning bathrooms creates problems for the students;

Whereas, CECD24 also identified other Capital Plan district needs based on school community feedback and will submit all requests to the School Construction Authority on January 8, 2020.

Be It Resolved; that on this day January 7, 2020, the Community Education Council for District 24 supports the need for these much needed capital plan improvements for our school district and hereby approves its submitted amendments to the 2020-2024 Capital Plan and strongly urges the Department of Education to react and approve our submitted Five Year Capital Plan priorities in a timely manner so changes can be implemented for the new school year.
