Resolution 191 (updated)

CEC24 Top Priorities for the 2025-2029 Five-Year Capital Plan

Whereas, Community Education Council for District 24 “CEC24” developed and identified these top Five- Year Capital Plan needs based on school community feedback:

Priority #1 – Repointing of Entire Building at Public School 91, 68-10 Central Avenue, Glendale, New York 11385; and

Priority #2 – Replace HVAC rooftop units and controls at Corona Arts & Science Academy, 98-11 44th Avenue, Corona, New York 11368; and

Priority #3 – Upgrade Windows at Intermediate School 61, 98-50 50th Avenue, Corona, New York; and

Priority #4 – Replace HVAC controls at Public School 229, 67-25 51st Road, Woodside, New York; and

Priority #5 - Building of an Annex at PS/IS 119, 74-01 78th Avenue, Glendale, New York 11385; and

Whereas, CEC24 also identified other Capital Plan district needs based on school community feedback and will submit all requests to the School Construction Authority on January 16, 2026.

Be It Resolved; that on this day January 27, 2026, the Community Education Council 24 supports the need for these much needed capital plan improvements for our school district and hereby approves its submitted amendments to the 2025 - 2029 Capital Plan and strongly urges the Department of Education to react and approve our submitted Five-Year Capital Plan priorities in a timely manner so changes can be implemented for the new school year.
